THURSTON COUNTY  
MEDIC ONE EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE AND  
SERVICES PROPOSITION NO. 1

The Board of County Commissioners of Thurston County adopted Ordinance No.

16014 concerning property taxes for Medic One emergency medical care and services. This proposition would increase the 2022 regular property tax levy for emergency medical care and services to \$0.35/\$1,000 of assessed value (approximately \$0.06 increase); set the limit factor for calculating levy rates in each of the years 2023 through 2027 at 107%, or approximately \$0.03/\$1,000 per year; provide that the levy for 2027 would be used to compute limits on levies after 2027 under chapter 84.55 RCW; and exempt eligible seniors, veterans and disabled persons under RCW 84.36.381.
